The European Federation of Psychology Teachers' Associations (EFPTA) invites you to **submit a poster** for our upcoming conference in **Ljubljana, 16-19 April 2026**. This is your platform to **showcase your projects, network with international colleagues, and contribute to the future of pre-university psychology education**.

### ✿ Why should you present?

- **International visibility:** share your pedagogical initiatives with a global audience of peers
- **Professional growth:** get feedback on your research or classroom innovations in a supportive, collaborative environment
- **Earlybird discount:** authors of accepted posters will be offered the Earlybird rate (110 euro) for the conference registration fee.

### 💡 What can your poster be about?

We welcome any topic relating to psychology education at the pre-university level, including:

- **Classroom innovations:** digital tools, pedagogical strategies, "active learning" techniques
- **Curriculum design:** designing courses or psychology's place in the overall school curriculum
- **Empirical research:** findings on teaching, learning, assessment, or student transitions to university
- **Inclusion & support:** mentoring, student well-being, and diversity initiatives
- **Interdisciplinary projects:** cooperation between subjects or across international borders.

### Submission & format details

- **Format:** A1 or A2 size, portrait orientation.
- **Language:** English or Slovenian
- **Design:** keep it visual! Your poster should be readable from 1 metre away (tools like Canva or PowerPoint are your best friends here)
- **Presentation:** You bring the poster; we provide the boards and fixing materials. At least one author must be present to chat about the work during our dedicated poster sessions.

- Submission deadline: 27 February 2026
- Notification of acceptance: 16 March 2026
